

Jan. 1st – Dec. 31st, 2008, their 4-H age is 14.

Jan. 1st – Dec. 31st, 2007, their 4-H age is 15.

Jan. 1st – Dec. 31st, 2006, their 4-H age is 16.

Jan. 1st – Dec. 31st, 2005, their 4-H age is 17.

Jan. 1st – Dec. 31st, 2004, their 4-H age is 18.


